

Tuesday/Friday - Gold Group (In-person)




OPTIONS

2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR



1.) Return to School - Hybrid Model: Schools will only allow for half capacity during in-person days

- Both in-school and remote learning (scholars will either attend in person on Monday/Thursday or Tuesday/Friday).
- Only half of the scholars will attend each day.
- Scholars will be required to participate in remote learning during their off days.
- Scholars will be socially distanced through space and barriers while in school.
- There will be frequent hand washing and sanitizing procedures in place.
- All staff will be required to wear face coverings (masks, shields).
- All staff and scholars will be subject to temperature check upon entering buildings. Anyone whose temperature is above 100.4 will be sent home.



2.) Warrensville Virtual Academy: 100% Remote Continuous Learning (5 days a week)

- All classes will be virtual through Google Classroom.
- Scholars will be required to attend daily live lessons at scheduled times.
- Scholars are required to remain enrolled the entire first semester (Up until January 22, 2021).
- All online assignments and assessments will be utilized to determine your scholar's course grades.



BOTH Design Models will follow WHCSD's:

- Curriculum and be taught by WHCSD teachers
- Grading Policies
- SpEd and Intervention Supports



Switching Options:

A continuous and consistent learning environment is best for student success. For the sake of continuity, transfers from one learning option to another should not occur during the semester (August—January). A process will be outlined for student experiencing extenuating circumstances.

HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOL



GENERAL SAFETY

- All students and staff will be required to wear face coverings in common areas (hallways, office areas, etc.).
- It is highly recommended that face coverings are worn inside the classrooms. Accommodations will be made for those students or staff members individually who may have medical issues with breathing
- Some areas within the building will require a higher level of cleaning. High-touch surfaces as in sinks, desks, and doorknobs/handles should receive a priority level of attention with regards to disinfecting.
- Arrival/dismissal will be staggered.
- Students will not hold assemblies or lunch in a large group.
- Classroom sizes/numbers will be reduced.
- Scheduled restroom breaks.
- Upon entering the building or accessing the bus, student temperatures will be taken.
- Classroom desks will be setup to provide social distancing (between 3-6 feet). An additional layer of protection will be provided on each desk where desk shields will be installed.
- Hallway transitions will be minimized and may include teacher transitions instead of students.
- Hallway markers and visual cues will be placed throughout the buildings.
- Visitors and volunteers will only be allowed in extenuating circumstances.
- Staff will be required to wear facial coverings, take temperatures and do a symptom assessment daily before work.

TRANSPORTATION

- The bus driver will wear a face covering at all times.
- The students will wear a face covering while waiting at the bus stop and while riding the bus.
- Students are asked to social distance at the bus stop while awaiting transport.
- Student temperatures will be taken prior to entering the bus.
- Parents of elementary students will be asked to walk and wait for student temperatures to be taken.
- Sanitation stations are placed on each bus for usage as students enter.
- Students may be seated up to 2 per seat, within the same family whenever possible.
- If a student is not able to wear a face covering on the bus due to developmental or medical reasons, the school will encourage (but not require) families to provide individual transportation for their child.
- Buses will be sanitized completely after each student routes.
- Drivers will be provided with various materials decrease the chances of spreading the COVID-19 virus (Thermometers, masks, gloves, cleaning materials, etc).

ATHLETICS

- The WHCSD Athletic Department will adopt the protocols provided by the Ohio Department of Health guidelines for athletic participation.
- All participants and coaches must maintain 6-foot social distancing, except in instances where it is not possible.
- Install physical barriers or visual cues to ensure spectators must maintain 6 feet between families.
- All participants, coaches, instructors or umpires must follow the “no touch” rule to avoid physical contact. This includes high-fives, huddles or other close contact.
- Coaches and instructors should designate space for each player to maintain six-foot space during practice.
- There will be no congregating before or after the training, practice or event.
- Practice facilities must have enough space for social distancing on and off the field of play.
