In Warrensville, You'll Find:

- All day, tuition free pre-kindergarten
 - Services children with disabilities ages three through five in an inclusive environment for learning with typically developing peers ages four to five
 - Typically developing peers should be four years old on or before September 30th of that year of enrollment
- Highly trained teachers with expertise in early childhood education
- A comprehensive, evidenced-based curriculum that is aligned with Ohio's Early Learning Standards in all essential domains for kindergarten readiness
- A 4-STAR ODE Step Up to Quality program that emphasizes hands-on learning to meet the needs, interests, and abilities of each student
- Low staff to child ratio
- Free breakfast and lunch



Pre-Kindergarten Readiness

By fall, your child should be able to:

- Give his or her full name
- Respond when hearing his or her full name
- Use the restroom independently
- Listen to and follow simple directions
- Take care of toys and equipment and put them away after play.
- Demonstrate basic movements (run, hop, jump, throw)
- Count to five
- Identify colors

Tips to Help Your Child Succeed:

- Read with your child daily
- Give your child simple responsibilities at home
- Have fun with numbers – count objects you see in the environment
- Help your child learn to share
- Play with your child – roll, kick or throw a ball back and forth
- Have your child identify colors seen in the environment
